

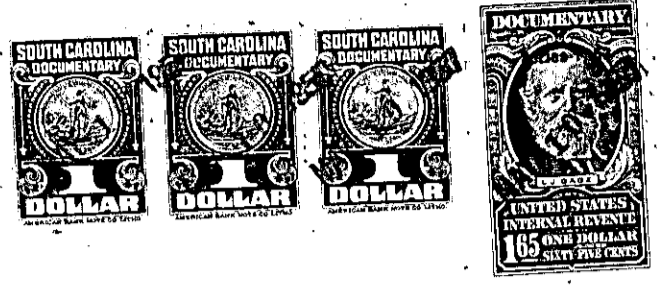

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Glenn P. Morgan

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Glenn P. Morgan all that lot or parcel of land located on the East side of new road leading from Butterstreet to the entrance of Lake Lanier, this new road now designated as Glenwood. The lot begins at a pin at the edge of above Road, and has a frontage of 120 feet with 78 feet to the North and 48 feet to the South of a marked pine, the Northern boundry to be 250<sup>feet</sup>/at right angles to above mentioned road, and the Southern Boundry 250 feet, also at right angles to road, and 120 feet across the rear, this line parallel to the front line. This property was deeded to me by E. Inman, Master under the case of Westonvs Morgan, Gentry, et al.
