All of that parcel or tract of land located in Highland Township of Green-Ville County, South Carolina, lying on the north side of Few's Bridge Road and about one mile southwest from Few's Chapel Methodist Church, and being all of the remainder of Tract No. 1 on a plat of property made for the J.M.
