HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 6 of property of 7. E. McClain, as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book X, at page 159, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of an unnamed road, (now known as U Drive) and it there has the joint front corner of Lots.
