CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

EDWIN A. LONG, 1303 East North St., Greenville, S. C.

AND

W. WILSON WAKEFIELD, 200 Batesview Dr., Greenville, S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of

GREENVILLE, S. C. LIONS CLUB
(Greenville, S. C.)

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 29th day of August, A. D. 1957, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than as above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville-Piedmont, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is GREENVILLE, S. C. LIONS CLUB

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to render community service and to promote community welfare, to promote high social, business and professional standards and to do any and all things incidental or pertinent thereto.

FIFTH: The names and residences of all Managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows:

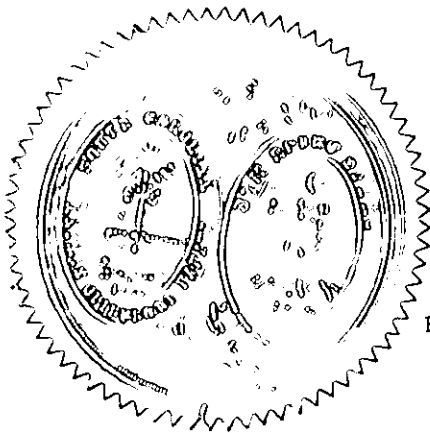
