I, A. D. Tanner, Jr., as Executor of the last will and testament of A. D. Tanner, Sr. consent to and approve the foregoing conveyance and in doing so waive the power and authority given me under the will to sell at either public or private sale the described property and in doing so I certify and declare that the personal property, exclusive of that referred to in Item 11 of the will of the said A. D. Tanner, Sr. is ample to pay all debts of the estate and that there is no necessity for a sale of the described property.
