

First Baptist Church on the east, lands now or formerly owned
by James Flynn on the north, and bounded on the south by
U. S. Highway #29, being lots numbers 22, 23 and 24 on a plat
of subdivision #1 of property of W. M. Shockley, and having
the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of U. S.
