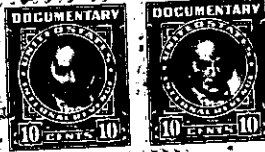

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That W. L. BURGER

CLERK in the State aforesaid,
GREENVILLE

in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand and No/100ths (\$7,000.00) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto LARRY R. BURGER:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southeastern side of Anderson Road (S.C. Highway 81) near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 10 as shown on a plat prepared by Dalton & Neves, dated 1939, entitled "Anderson Street Highlands", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book J at page 157, and having according to said plat and also according to a more recent plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated July 10, 1958, entitled "Property of Larry R. Burger"; the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Anderson Road (S.C. Highway 81) at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10, which iron pin is located 100 feet in a Southwesterly direction from the point where the Southeastern side of Anderson Road (S.C. Highway 81) intersects with the Southwestern side of Somerset Avenue (formerly known as East King Street), and running thence with the line of Lot No. 9 S. 47-20 E. 159.7 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 64; thence with the line of Lot No. 64 S. 42-40 W. 50 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11; thence with the line of Lot No. 11 N. 47-20 W. 160.4 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Anderson Road (S.C. Highway 81); thence with the Southeastern side of Anderson Road (S.C. Highway 81) N. 43-27 E. 50 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Marion G. Hester, dated July 23, 1958, and to be recorded herewith in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

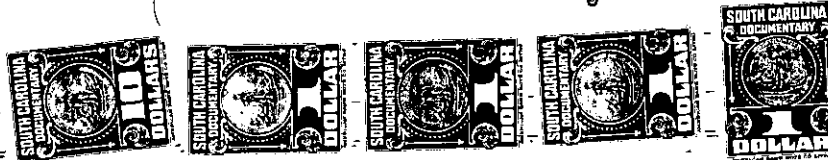
