- I, Ormande A. Kieb , Assistant Postmaster General of the United States, Bureau of Facilities, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Order No. 55884 of the Postmaster General (20 Federal Register 3548) do hereby declare that:

- (b) The public use for which such lands are taken are to provide for necessary postal facilities.
- 2. A description of said lands sufficient for the identification thereof is set forth in Schedule A, annexed hereto and made a part hereof.
- 3. The estate hereby taken for said public use as aforesaid is an estate in fee simple absolute in and to said lands.
- 4. A plan showing the said lands is annexed hereto as Schedule B and made a part hereof.
