HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Ellen Thompson, her heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Austin Township,
Greenville County, South Carolina, designated as Lot No. 2 on plat
of Property of Richard H. Morton Estate, containing 6.67 acres,
and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of a County road at the southeast
corner of Tract No. 1 and running thence along center of said County
road, N. 70-22 E. 240 feet; thence still with said road, N. 66-13 E.
160 feet to an iron pin corner of Tract No. 3; thence with line of
