 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by  
 these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said McDonald McCall, his  
 heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville  
 County, State of South Carolina

ALL MY INTEREST, as wife and heir of J. M. McCall, who died  
 intestate on the 5th day of July, 1947, in that certain piece, parcel  
 or tract of land situate, lying and being in state and county aforesaid,  
 known as a portion of the land conveyed to J. M. McCall, decedent, by  
 W. T. Newby by deed recorded in Deed Book 244, at page 26, and having,
