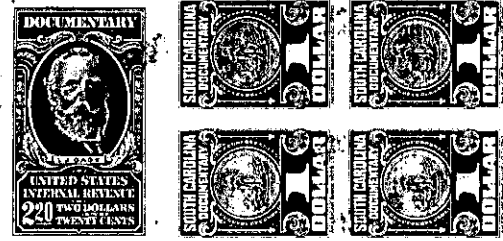

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located at Pelham, and being known as Lot Number Ninety Three (No. 93) on plat of Pelham Mill Village, as prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engrs., October, 1939; lying on the southwestern side of "A" Street, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:
