John C. Williams, his heirs and assigns forever:

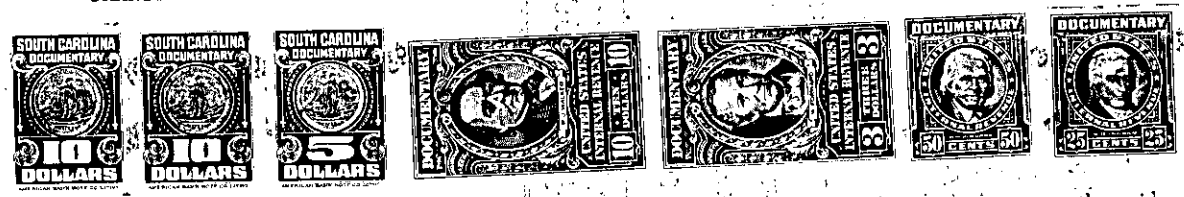
