That I, WILLIAM R. TIMMONS, JR., in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE AND NO/100--- DOLLARS, (\$2,445.00)

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. W. MANLEY, His Heirs and Assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot Number 114 of a subdivision known as McSwain Gardens, Section 2, a plat of which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book LL at Page 137, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northwestern side of Beaufort Street at the joint front corner of Lots 113 and 114 and running thence N 25-41 W 165.9 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 113 and 114; thence N 64-19 E 100 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 114 and 115; thence S 25-41 E 146.2 feet to a point on the Northwestern side of Beaufort Street at the joint front corner of Lots 114 and 115; thence with the Northwestern side of Beaufort Street S 53-44 W 56.2 feet to a point; thence continuing with the Northwestern side of Beaufort Street S 52-04 W 45.8 feet to the point of beginning.
