

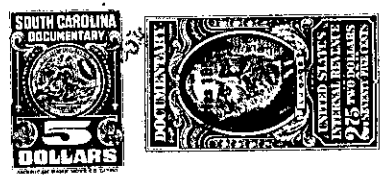
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That We, LUCILE L. SMITH, LOU ANNE SMITH

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto RICHARD C. REYNOLDS and SARAH P. REYNOLDS:

All that parcel or lot of land lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being designated as Lot No. 10 as shown on Plat No. Three, Cherokee Forest, prepared by J. Mac Richardson, R.L.S., in January, 1959, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book QQ at pages 36 and 37, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a concrete monument at the Northwestern intersection of Roberta Drive and Red Cherry Lane and running thence in said intersection N. 56-34 E. 21.6 feet to an iron pin; thence along the Western side of Red Cherry Lane N. 12-33 E. 181 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said lane N. 8-39 E. 119.5 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running N. 85-29 W. 118.2 feet to an iron pin; thence running along the joint line of Lots Nos. 9 and 10 S. 10-31 W. 303.4 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Roberta Drive; thence with Roberta Drive S. 79-29 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

The foregoing lot is a portion of that conveyed to the late Grady T. Smith by deeds recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Books 380 at page 474, and 345 at page 241; the grantors herein being the heirs-at-law of said Grady T. Smith.
