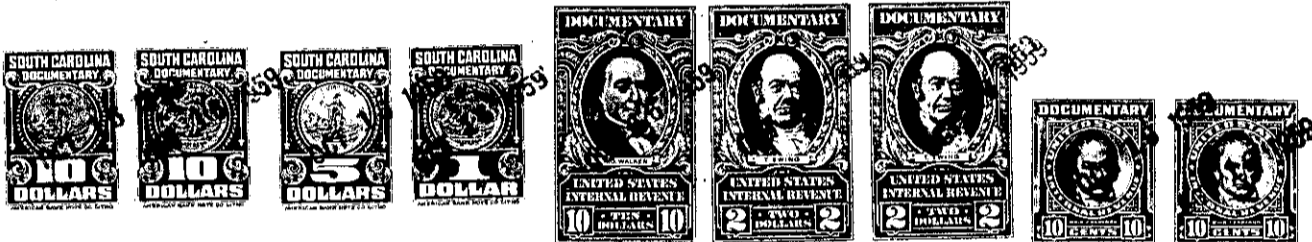
Know All Men by These Presents:

Williamson, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as lot #18, on the Southern side of Forestwood Drive, part of Broadleaf Forest, according to survey by Jones & Sutherland, Engineers, August 1958, plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book MM, at page 64, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
