Althoff in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seventeen Hundred and No/100 (\$1700.00) - - - - DOLLARS, and assumption of mortgage set forth below to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Robert N. McNeill, Jr. and Claytie L. McNeill, their heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, designated as Lot No. 15 on the West side of Conley Street according to a plat of Belmont Heights, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "GG" at page 54, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Conley Street, said pin being 160 feet North of Sanford Court, and running thence S. 65-17 W. 126 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 80-41 W. 109.9 feet to an iron pin on an unnamed street; thence along the East side of said street N. 5-32 E. 82.2 feet to an iron pin; thence still along said street N. 16-00 E. 22.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 65-17 E. 185.7 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Conley Street; thence along said street S. 24-43 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 608 at page 16. As part of the consideration hereto, the grantees hereby assume and agree to pay the remaining balance due on a certain mortgage in favor of The Prudential Insurance Company of America, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 624 at page 205, the present balance due on said mortgage being \$11,065.16.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

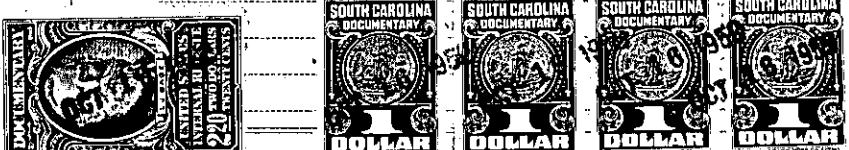
