WHEREAS, A. W. Hill County Treasurer of said Greenville County, did issue his warrants directed to the Delinquent Tax Collector for said County and State by authority of the acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina and the statute laws of said State, against Josephus Boyd

WHEREAS, more than twelve months have elapsed since the date of said sale, and the defaulting taxpayer(s), or any other party interested, have failed to redeem said land so sold for taxes;

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantee(s), M. O. Center

his heirs and assigns: All that certain, parcel or lot of land situate and being in the State and County aforesaid, on the South Side of Ashmore Street near the town of Greer, having a frontage of fifty (50) feet on Ashmore street by depth of 173.7 feet on the east side, 168.4 on the west side and known and designated as Lot No. 18 on a plat of land known as the J.
