September, A. D. 1959, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the *The Observer*, a newspaper published in the County of *Greenville*, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is THE GOSPELLIGHT TABERNACLE

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is
Greenville County, S. C., near Pelham, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to preach the christian doctrine as taught in the Holy Bible.

FIFTH: The names and residences of all Managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows:

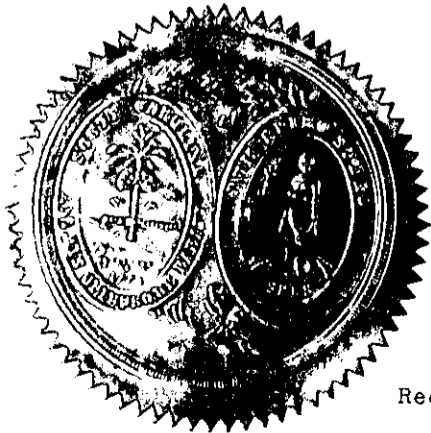
