KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, G. Heyward Mahon, Jr.,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five and No/100 Dollars, and love and affection for my wife, the grantee herein, ~~Dollars~~

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by my wife, Elizabeth W. Mahon, the grantee herein,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Elizabeth W. Mahon, her heirs and assigns, forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the Southeast side of Altamont Road on Paris Mountain, and having according to a survey made by Pickel & Pickel, Engineers; July 28, 1948, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southeast corner of the intersection of the Altamont Road and Huckleberry Road and running thence with the Southeast side of Huckleberry Road, N. 78-40 E. 65 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said Road, N. 35-50 E. 283 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said road, N. 50-55 E. 350 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along Huckleberry Road, N. 65-15 E. 167 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 16-45 W. 1,393 feet to a point; thence S. 41-23 E. 158 feet to a point; thence S. 71-31 W. 511-5 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Altamont Road; thence with the East side of Altamont Road N. 39-30 W. 105 feet to an iron pin; thence, still with said road, N. 28-38 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said road, N. 2-55 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence with said road, N. 19-45 E. 271 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along Altamont Road, N. 15-21 E. 275 feet to the beginning corner and containing 16 acres, more or less.

Being the property conveyed to the grantor by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office of Greenville County in Deed Book 356 at page 129.
