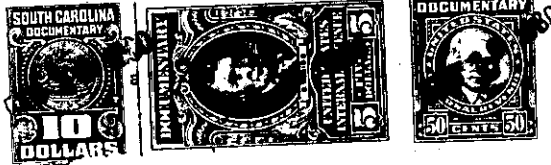

Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, adjoining lands
of R. B. Hunt, R. N. Hendricks and others, containing 33 acres, more or
