in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. C. Harris and Lucile A. Harris, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 9 of Glenwood Acres, according to a plat thereof prepared by C. C. Jones, C.E. December, 1951 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book AA, Page 183 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Elmira Street at the joint front corner Lots Nos. 8 and 9 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 25-24 E. 167.3 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 11; thence with the line of Lot No. 11, N. 60-51 E. 90.2 feet to an iron pin the joint rear corner Lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 21-46 W. 161.6 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of said Elmira Street, joint front corner Lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence along the southeastern side of said Street, S. 64-36 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by J. W. Cannon by his deed dated April 10, 1953 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 476, at Page 222.
