All that certain piece or parcel of land in the Lake Lanier Subdivision, Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, S. C., lying, being and situate on the Eastside of West Lake Shore Drive and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an I.P. on the Eastside of West Lake Shore Drive (said I.P. bearing S. 34-20 E. 30 ft. from an I.P. at the front corner between lots 1171 and 1172 in the Lake Lanier Subdivision) and running thence S. 50-40 E. 31.7 ft. to an I.P. at the edge of the waters of Lake Lanier; thence S. 38-41 W. 25 ft. along the edge of the waters of Lake Lanier to an I.P.; running thence N. 42-04 W. 35.4 ft. to an I.P. on the eastern edge of West Lake Shore Drive; thence along and with West Lake Shore Drive N. 48-59 E. 20 ft. to an I.P., being the point of beginning.
