presents do grant, bargain, sell and releasex max the xaid all my right, title and interest in and to an undivided one-half (1/2) interest in the below-described property, reserving, however, unto myself the right to use, enjoy, occupy, and receive any income from the same for and during the duration of my life, unto CLAIRE FONTAINE RICE, her heirs and assigns, forever:
