of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said E. Caroline Harris Head

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings
and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in _____
Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being known and
designated as Tract No. 1-C on a plat of property of J. D. Harris
Estate made by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, January, 1953, revised November
13, 1960, and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County
in Plat Book MM, Page 189, and having according to said plat the
following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the eastern edge of the concrete of
the Old Augusta Road, joint front corner of Tracts No. 1-B and No. 1-C,
and running thence along the line of TRact 1-B, N. 34-33 W. 650 feet to
an iron pin in the line of Tract No. 1-B, joint rear corner of Tracts
No. 1-C and No. 2; thence along the line of Tract No. 2, S. 23-42 W.
