AGREEMENT JUL 6 1961.

THIS AGREEMENT made by and between James B. Foy and D. Carl Smith, hereinafter referred to as the Retailer, and Ben K. Norwood and Ben K. Norwood, Jr., d/b/a Ben K. Norwood and Company, private bankers, hereinafter referred to as the Lender.

WITNESSETH:

That the Retailer is desirous of operating a retail clothing business known as Smith-Foy, Inc. in the Pleasantburg Shopping Center, Greenville, S. C., and is in need of money to finance said operation and Ben K. Norwood and Ben K. Norwood, Jr., d/b/a Ben K. Norwood and Company, private bankers, are desirous of lending the money to the said Retailer to operate a store.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the Retailer and the Lender hereby enter into the following agreement:

- 1. The Lender shall extend a line of credit not to exceed Thirty Thousand and no/100 (\$30,000.00) Dollars, which credit shall become available to the Retailer for the purchase of merchandise for the Pleasantburg store on July 1, 1961.
- 2. The Retailer agrees to pay the lender the following charges for moneys advanced on this Thirty Thousand and no/100 (\$30,000.00) Dollar line of credit:
 - a. From One and no/100 (\$1.00) Dollar to Five Thousand and no/100 (\$5,000.00) Dollars, One Twenty-Second (1/22) of One (1%) per cent.
 - b. From Five Thousand and no/100 (\$5,000.00)
 Dollars to Fifteen Thousand and no/100
 (\$15,000.00) Dollars, One Twenty-Third
 (1/23) of One (1%) per cent.
 - c. From Fifteen Thousand and no/100 (\$15,000.00) Dollars to Twenty-Five Thousand and no/100 (\$25,000.00) Dollars, One Twenty-Fourth (1/24) of One (1%) per cent.
