County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as tract number 2
on a plat of the estate of J. B. Day and Mellie E. Day, by Terry
F. Dill, Surveyor, dated June, 1961, and having, according to said
plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the northern side of Hunt's Bridge Road joint
front corner of tracts 1 and 2 and running thence along the common
line of tracts 1 and 2 N. 25-16 W. 2,010 feet to a point; thence
running N. 20-18 E. 490 feet crossing Armstrong Creek to a point;
thence running along the joint line of tracts nos. 2 and 7 N. 66-0
W. 65 feet to a point; thence running along the line of tract no. 2
and 6 S. 20-18 W. 420 feet to a point; thence continuing along the
