








All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being at the Southwestern corner of the intersection of Argonne Drive and Tomassee Avenue in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 26 as shown on a plat prepared by R.E.
