did on the **19th** day of **February**, 19 **62**, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
- SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is **J. R. CHANDLER WELL DRILLING COMPANY**
- THIRD: That the principal place of business is **Ware Place, Greenville County, S. C.**
- FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is **drill and bore water wells, to do test drilling, to do quarry drilling and any and all things incident to or necessary for such business; to acquire, own, and sell real estate and to lease real estate and personal property.**

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is **Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500.00) Dollars** payable **Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars** as of this date and **Twenty-Five Hundred (\$2500.00) Dollars** at date to be fixed by directors

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is **Seventy-Five (75)** of the par value of **One Hundred (\$100.00) per share**-----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the **17th** day of **February**, 19 **62**, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: **J. R. Chandler, Jr., and Mary L. Chandler**

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, **J. R. Chandler, Jr.** ;
as Vice-President, **Mary L. Chandler** ; as Secretary, **Mary L. Chandler** ;
as Treasurer, **J. R. Chandler, Jr.**

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in **Greenville Evening Piedmont** a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
