in consideration of EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE (\$875.00) Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto W. N. LESLIE, His Heirs and Assigns,

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, better known and described as Lot 13 A, Section "C", of the property known as Glenn Farms, as shown on Plat of Property of James L. and Ella Mae Taylor by J. C. Hill, L. S. 805; the same being recorded in Plat Book AAA at Page 17, Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, being also a portion of the original Lot 13 in Section C, Glenn Farms as noted in Plat Book M-75; and, having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds;

BEGINNING at an old iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 12 and 13 A on Glenn Road; and thence running N. 13-40 W. 220 Feet along the line of Lots Nos. 12 and 13 A to an old iron pin; thence, running N. 76-20 E. 50 Feet along the rear line to the joint corner of Lots Nos. 13 A and 13 B to an iron pin; thence running S. 13-40 E. 199 Feet along the side line of said Lots Nos. 13 A and 13 B to an iron pin, nail and cap; and thence running S. 54-12 W. 53.45 feet along the line of said Glenn Road, to the point of beginning.
