All that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the east side of Pine Street Extension in the City of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being a portion of Lots Nos. 8-C and 8-D of the J. B. Burnett Estate, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of Pine Street Extension, iron pin on the east side thereof, and runs thence S. 87-15 E. 261 feet to an iron pin on the Finley or Crain line; thence with that line, S. 1-10 E. 80 feet to iron pin on the same line; thence N. 87-15 W. 263.1 feet to point in said street extension (iron pin on east side thereof); thence along said extension N. 0-20 E. 80 feet to the beginning point.
