KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT

I, Lorrie C. Charles, of Dade County, Florida

in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of twenty Five $\frac{1}{100}$ (\$25.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. H. Charles, of Lancaster County, in the State aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. H. Charles, all my one-half (1/2) undivided right, title, and interest in and to:

All that tract or parcel or land, situate, lying and being in "Rowe Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on Branch waters of Saluda River and lying between Georgia Road and Piedmont road and containing one acre, more or less and having the following marks, bearings and distances: BEGINNING at a stone 3X3' in fork of roads; thence N 54 W, 3.00 to stone 3X3' on Piedmont Road; thence N 54 E, 3.00 to stone 3X3'; thence S 54 E, 3.00 to stone 3X3' on Georgia Road; thence S 54 E, 3.00 to the beginning corner adjoining lands now or formerly of B. Charles and Mar. Charles.

This property was conveyed to J. H. Charles, A. B. Breco and J. W. Charles, trustees of School District 4-F by Mary Charles by deed recorded October 24, 1912, in Deed Volume 21 at page 524 and it was stated in the deed that as long as the land was used for a school that the grantor released all claims to it. But if it ever was abandoned or not used for a school, then it was to go back to the grantor or her heirs or assigns. The trustees, so far as is known by the school district, are the only heirs by law of any Charles and this deed is to release to them any interest which the school district might have in the above property.
