- (4) To withdraw any and all funds from banks, post offices, savings and loan associations, and other places or institutions;
- (5) Sell, transfer, or mortgage, any or all of my property, both real and personal, of every kind and description, at such price (s) and on such terms as she may think advisable, and execute title deeds, bills of sale, stock certificate transfers, mortgages and notes, and any and all other written documents necessary or pertinent to the execution of this assignment;
- (6) Enter into and execute any and all other transactions, of all kinds and nature whatsoever, that I might lawfully enter into and execute in person;

And I do hereby now ratify and confirm any and all acts, deeds and transactions, which the said Lucille M. Bryant may lawfully do, claiming her right to act under this power of attorney.
