TRACT ONE: Beginning at a point in the East side of Laurens Street at Mrs. Grubb's corner, and running thence with her line S. 70 1/2 E. fifty feet; thence at right angles with the first mentioned line S. 19 1/2 W., twenty four feet along line of property belonging to the Estate of W. A. Moore, deceased; thence parallel with the first mentioned line N. 70 1/2 W. fifty feet to corner on Laurens Street; thence N. 19 1/2 E. twenty four feet to the beginning corner, containing 1200 square feet, more or less, together with the right to have and maintain an outside stairway reserved by T.
