C., lying on the west side of the Greer-Cneal Road (State Highway No. 101) and being shown and designated as Lots Nos. 1 and 2 on Plat of Property of E. B. Mason Estate made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, April 16th 1962, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-
