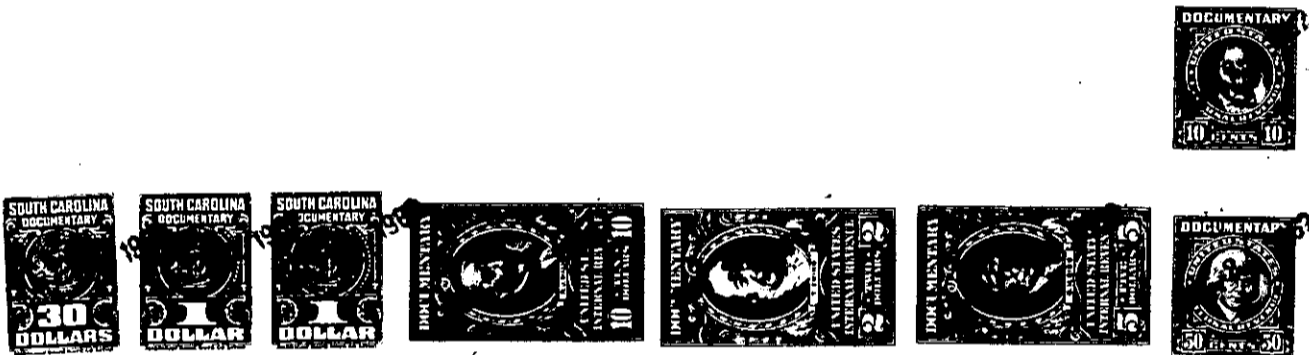
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, James R. Hall, of Greenville County,

in consideration of Sixteen Thousand and No/100 - - - - - Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Wayne C. Dilleshaw and Bobbie Jean Dilleshaw, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, being known and designated as Lot #21 of a subdivision known as Fenwick Heights, Section 2, as shown on a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, March 1959, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at Pages 44-45 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Fairlawn Circle, at the joint front corner of Lots 20 and 21 and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 22-15 W. 192.0 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot 24; thence along the line of that lot, S. 60-00 E. 45.0 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 21, 22 and 24; thence along the joint line of Lots 21 and 22, S. 19-13 W. 177.0 feet to an iron pin on the northwestern side of Fairlawn Circle; thence along the northwestern side of Fairlawn Circle, following the curvature thereof, the chords being S. 61-07 E. 57.0 feet, N. 83-00 E. 58.8 feet and N. 62-27 E. 70.0 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to me by Blue Ridge Realty Co., Inc. by its deed dated February 26, 1962 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 694, at Page 65.
