"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the northeast corner of Brookdale Avenue and Hanover Street, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 13 of Block E, on plat of Fair Heights, made by R. E. Dalton in October 1924, recorded in Plat Book F at Page 257, and described as follows:
