CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

JOHN W. NORWOOD, III and JOHN W. NORWOOD, JR.

both of

Stokes Building, Greenville, South Carolina

did on the 28th day of June, 19 61, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is NORWOOD CAPITAL CORPORATION

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Stokes Building, E. Coffee Street, Greenville, South Carolina

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is this corporation is organized and chartered expressly for the purpose of operating under the Small Business Investment Act of 1958 and will operate in the manner and shall have powers, responsibilities and be subject to the limitations provided by said Act and the regulations issued by the Small Business Administration thereunder.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Three Hundred Thousand (\$300,000.00)-- Dollars payable in cash

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Three Hundred Thousand (300,000) of the par value of One (\$1.00)-----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 6th day of June, 19 61, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: John W. Norwood, III, John W. Norwood, Jr., and Aileen D. Putman

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, John W. Norwood, III ; as Vice-President, John W. Norwood, Jr. ; as Secretary, Aileen D. Putman ; as Treasurer, John W. Norwood, Jr.

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville News a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
