

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Southwestern margin of U. S. Highway #176, and running thence South 26. deg. 45 min. West 94 feet to an iron pin; thence South 67 deg. West 200 feet to an iron pin in the branch; thence with said branch South 9 deg. East 310 feet passing a wild cherry tree to a stake; thence South 13 deg. 45 min. min. West 146 feet to a stake; thence South 13 deg. West 65 feet to a Spanish Oak in the outside line of the Acker property; thence North 50 deg. 18 min. West 353 feet to a stake; thence North 1 deg. 30 min. East 473.7 feet to an iron pin; thence North 53 deg. East 100 feet to an iron pin; thence North 20 deg. 30 min. East 41.5 feet to an iron pin; thence North 50 deg. East 257.5 feet to a stake in the Southwestern margin of U. S. Highway #176; thence with the margin of said Highway South 44 deg. 15 min. East 290 feet to the BEGINNING, containing 5.9 acres, more or less, and being the identical land conveyed by Ida Acker to Alex McLeod by deed dated October 15, 1951, recorded in Book 453, Page 254, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
