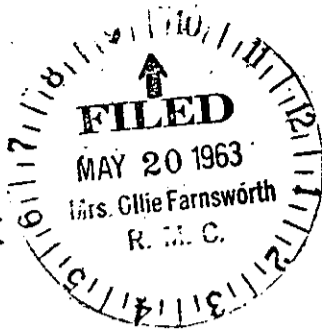

Arthur.
