Dollars (375.00), in hand, to the undersigned, hereinafter styled "Grantor", whether one or more, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Grantor does hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Warrant unto UNION CARBIDE CORPORATION, a New York Corporation, herein styled "Grantee", its successors and assigns, a right of way and easement to construct, lay, maintain, operate, repair, remove, change the size of and replace one (1) sewer line, of not more than ten inches (10 in.) in diameter, under, upon, over or through lands which the undersigned owns or in which the undersigned has an interest, situated in the County of Greenville, State of Couth Carolina, and described as follows:

All that lot of land being shown as lot numbered 2.1 Block 1, Sheet 305 of Greenville County Tax Maps, attached hereto and made a part of this instrument.

said lands being fully described in deed from Ernest Blakely to J. R. Richardson, recorded in Volume 252, Page 242, Deed Records of said County, to which reference is here made for further description.

The right of way herein granted shall be fifty (50) feet in width for construction purposes and after construction it shall revert to a permanent width of thirty (30) feet for maintenance and operating purposes.

This right of way shall run along the eastern side of Blakely load as shown on the attached map 305 and shall begin at the point where Blakely load intersects the joint lines of lots numbered 2.1 and 4.3 and run thence along the eastern side of Blakely load in a southeasterly direction across lot 2.1 to the point where Blakely Road intersects the joint line of lot 2.1 and the property of J. E. McGill.
