All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina just North of the Town of Simpsonville, S. C. and being lot No. 30 in a subdivision of lands known as Forest Park and shown as lot No. 30 on a plat entitled Map of Forest Park, prepared by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, October, 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB, Pages 70 and 71 and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds:
