- F. ALL SEWER DISPOSAL SHALL BE BY SEPTIC TANKS SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH, OR BY MUNICIPAL SEWERAGE SYSTEM.
- F. AN EASEMENT FIVE (5) FEET IN WIDTH IS RESERVED ALONG THE SOUTH SIDE OF EACH LOT FOR UTILITY INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE.
- G. ALL FUEL OIL TANKS SHALL BE SO LOCATED SO AS NOT TO BE VISIBLE FROM THE STREET.
- H. NO JUNK, VEHICLES OR INOPERABLE CARS CAN BE PERMANENTLY KEPT ON ANY LOT.
