All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southern side of Roberta Drive near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 50, as shown on Plat No. Three, Cherokee Forest, prepared by J. Mac Richardson, R.L.S., in January, 1959, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book QQ at pages 36 and 37, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of a turn-around of Roberta Drive, near the eastern terminus thereof, at the joint front corner of Lot No. 51 and running thence along the curve of the southern side of Roberta Drive to an iron pin the chord being N. 72-47 E. 45'; thence continuing with the southern side of Roberta Drive S. 14-02 E. 76.5' to an iron pin at the terminus of Roberta Drive; thence S. 35-30 E. 324.4' to an iron pin at Brushy Creek; thence N. 79-51 W. 162.7' to a concrete monument; thence N. 73-45 W. 206' to an iron pin on the line of Lot No. 51; thence N. 15-58 E. 191.7' to an iron pin on the southern side of Roberta Drive, the point of beginning.

The premises herein described are subject to a drainage easement 5 feet in width along the eastern side thereof, as shown on the plat referred to above.
