CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

Clyde D. Jenkins, Sr., Route 3, P. O. Box 126, Simpsonville, S. C.

did on the 31st day of December, 19 63, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is Jenk's, Inc.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Route 3, P. O. Box 124, Simpsonville, S. C. Greenville County -

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to acquire farm properties and other real estate by purchase, lease or otherwise and to improve and develop the same; to engage in and in general to conduct any and all aspects of the business of farmers, fruit growers, dairymen, livestock and poultry raisers, nurserymen and timbermen; to establish, maintain, and operate hunting, fishing and other recreational and entertainment facilities; and to do everything incidental or necessary for the conduct and operation of such businesses.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is (\$30,000.00) - Dollars payable in cash or property or both.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is (3000) shares of the par value of Ten (\$10.00) each - Dollars

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 28th day of December, 19 63, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Clyde D. Jenkins, Sr. and Clyde D. Jenkins, Jr.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Clyde D. Jenkins, Sr. ; as Vice-President, ; as Secretary, Clyde D. Jenkins, Jr. ; as Treasurer, Clyde D. Jenkins, Jr.

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greer Citizen

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
