ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville, South Carolina, County of Greenville, on and near North Saluda River, being all of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, containing in the aggregate ten (10) acres, more or less, being described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stone, XO, in the Gap Creek Road and running thence S. 49 1/2 W., 20.25 chains to a stone, XO; thence east 16.30 chains to a stake, xo, in said Road; thence with said Road, N. 04 2/3 W., 12.50 chains to the beginning corner, bounded by lands now or formerly of Beattie and others.
