KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That for and in consideration of FOUR HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$400.00) Dollars to the undersigned grantor, Christ Church Cemetery, a corporation of South Carolina, in hand paid by Annie Macbeth and Minnie Macbeth Lent, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Annie Macbeth and Minnie Lent a lot or parcel of ground, including perpetual care, in Christ Church Cemetery, Greenville County, South Carolina, designated as Lot No. 4 & Part of Lot No. 1, (South, one third) Section 32; the same being described and designated as above, in accordance with plat recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H page 300 (64 sq. ft.)

It is distinctly understood that said lot is to be used exclusively for the burial of human bodies of the white race, and is sold and conveyed subject to all rules and regulations printed on the back hereof, and any additions or amendments for the government of the Cemetery which may hereafter be adopted.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above granted property to the said Annie Macbeth and Minnie Macbeth Lent, their

heirs and assigns forever; subject, however, to the restrictions and limitations above referred to.

AND Christ Church Cemetery does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend the said premises to the said Annie Macbeth and Minnie Macbeth Lent / their heirs and assigns against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof; subject, however, to the restrictions and limitations herein contained.
