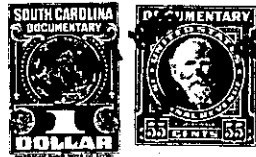

ORDER OF COURT
IN THE COUNTY COURT



To All Whom These Presents Shall Come:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, P. V. Waddell

on or about the 2nd day of January in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and Sixty Five exhibited his
complaint in the County Court for the County aforesaid, against
James P. Waddell, a minor, by his Guardian ad Litem, Annabel Jones

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard
on the 8th day of January 1965,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and
decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for
the County aforesaid, to W. A. Jones

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of
Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto
the said W. A. Jones; all the right, title and interest of the minor
defendant, James P. Waddell, in and to the following real estate:

All those pieces, parcels or lots of land located in the County
of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and situate and lying and
being on the northern side of Anderson Road and being known and
designated as Lots Nos. 5 and 6 on a plat entitled Sterling College
Park Addition Property of Traxler Real Estate Company prepared by
Dalton and Neves, dated June, 1940.

This deed is made pursuant to the Order of Court in the above entitled
action and conveys the interest of the minor defendant, James P.
Waddell, to W. A. Jones for the consideration of \$500.00. The \$500.00
was paid by W. A. Jones to Annabel Jones as General Guardian for the
minor defendant in accordance with the Order of Court.
