

(including front, side and rear elevations), specifications (including construction materials), and plot plan showing the location of such building has been approved in writing as to conformity and harmony of external design with existing structures in the subdivision, and as to location of the building with respect to topography and finished grade elevation by Donald S. Tarbox and Quentin O. Ball, or either of them, or a committee to be appointed by them, of which Quentin O. Ball shall be the chairman, or by a representative designated by a majority of the members of such committee. The undersigned property owner reserves the right to change or increase the membership of said committee at any time. In the event of death or resignation of any member of said committee, the remaining member or members shall have full authority to approve or disapprove such design and location, or to designate a representative with such authority. In the event said committee, or its designated representatives, fails to approve or disapprove of such design and location within thirty (30) days after said plans and specifications have been submitted to it, or in any event, if no suit to enjoin the erection of such buildings or the making of such alterations has been commenced prior to the completion thereof, such approval will not be required, and this covenant will be deemed to have been fully complied with. Neither the members of such committee, nor its designated representative, shall be entitled to any compensation for services performed pursuant to this covenant. The powers and duties of such committee, or its designated representative, shall cease on and after April 1, 1990. Thereafter the approval described in this covenant shall not be required unless, prior to said date and effective thereon, a written instrument shall be executed by the then record owners of a majority of the lots in this subdivision, and duly recorded, appointing a representative or representatives who shall thereafter exercise the same powers previously exercised by said committee.

3. No building shall be located nearer to the front lot lines or nearer to the side street lines than the building lines shown

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
