

9. All sewerage disposal shall be by septic tank meetings ✓
the approval of the State Board of Health until such time as
municipal or community sewerage disposal becomes available.

10. Any connection with the water line on said streets
shall be at purchaser's expense and the use of such water shall
be confined to the respective lot.

11. All tanks, barrels, or containers for fuel oil shall be
placed below the ground or concealed.

12. The Committee provided for in Paragraph 2 above shall
have the right and power to cut or authorize the cutting and
laying out of one or more streets or roads through any unimproved
lots still owned by the undersigned, and the further right and
power to recut or authorize the recutting of any lot or lots
so as to face the same on any new cut street or road.
