POWER OF ATTORNEY

Re: Springwood Cemetery  
Lot 116

To whom it may concern:

This is to authorize Mrs. Daisy T. Wilson, 115 Ridgeland Drive, Greenville, South Carolina, to act in my behalf as my agent for the sale of five of six burial plots in lot 116, Springwood Cemetery.

As the son and sole surviving heir of the late T.C. Johnson in whose name the title of this cemetery lot is recorded ( Dated October 6, 1920, Vol. 6, page 636 ) I appoint Daisy T. Wilson as my representative in any and all matters pertaining to the sale of this property.

My consent is hereby given for the opening of the grave (which is now centrally located in lot 116) of my late father, T.C. Johnson, under the supervision of Mrs. Wilson, and subsequent re-interment of my father's remains in a corner burial plot of lot 116. Mrs. Wilson is to have full discretion in this matter as to the corner burial plot of lot 116 to be selected,

Mrs. Wilson may, at her option, arrange that the expense in connection with the transfer of my father's remains, as indicated above, be deducted from the selling price of the five remaining burial plots in lot 116. The total sale price of the five burial plots is to be established by Mrs. Wilson in accordance with the current fair market value of these lots.
